

VASSAR AREA SKILLS TESTING

Driving Skills Test Checklist

VEHICLE SAFETY CHECK

Before beginning the test, the State of Michigan requires that we do a full safety check of the vehicle. The following things **must** be operational on the vehicle you bring for your test.

- A. **BRAKES & BRAKE LIGHTS**, including the **CENTER brake light** CENTER BRAKE LIGHT MUST WORK.
- B. **TURN SIGNALS (Front and Rear) Headlights if necessary during test**
- C. **HORN must work**
- D. **SPEEDOMETER**
- E. **SEAT BELTS**
- F. **WINDSHIELD** – no view obstructing cracks, **WASHER AND WIPERS, & WINDOWS** – driver's window must be operable
- G. **TIRES** – not bald or showing cords

If **any** of these items are not working, we **CANNOT** do the test and you will be required to pay **\$30.00**.

DOCUMENTATION

- A. **Vehicle Registration & Tab** – must be current
- B. **Proof of Insurance** – must be current
- C. **Michigan Graduated License** (under 18 yrs. old) No Photocopy
or **Michigan Temporary Instruction Permit** (over 18 yrs. old) No Photocopy
- D. **Segment 2 Completion** (under 18 yrs. old)
- E. **Driving Log** or phone app showing 50 hours, including 10 night (under 18yrs. Old)

If **any** of the required documents are missing, we **CANNOT** do the test and you will be required to pay **\$30.00**.

State law requires that **NO OTHER PASSENGERS** are allowed in the vehicle besides the parent or guardian, unless you are over 18, in which case, only the examiner is allowed.
